- ▶ Standard equipment includes: moldboard contouring cylinders, one section trip edge, twin ram reverse or worm gear reverse kit, oscillating drive bar and para-level lift chain arrangement.

- ▶ Self aligning bearings allow for proper positioning while eliminating torsional stresses on moldboard structural supporting members.
- ▶ Two 3-1/2” bore by 6” hydraulic cylinders work automatically in conjunction with the reversing mechanism.
